- Focus will be on improving quality of key research outputs and enhancing effectiveness of dissemination, in particular through involving private sector and civil society stakeholders


ARTNeT Phase II - Vision

ARTNeT: 2020

- ARTNeT as the leading regional platform for "homegrown" trade & investment policy research/analysis and related TA/CB
- Creation of ARTNeT cells in research institutions in the region
 - Strengthen implementation of ARTNeT activities at "home",
 - Facilitate fund raising, and
 - Sustain members' commitment to ARTNeT.

- Network Structure
 - Members, Core Partners, Partners, Associate
 Partners
 - Institutional Advisory Board (IAB)
 - Composition revised based on members' contribution to the network
 - Creation of an ARTNeT Steering Committee
 - 4 <u>rotating</u> IAB members, 4 <u>invited</u> government experts, 1 advocacy/media org., 1 private sector
 - Will approve revisions to research programme

- Research Programme [focus]
 - Trade, Investment and Policy Coherence
 - Emphasis on policy linkages and finding out what environment / linked policies are needed to ensure trade and investment reforms lead to inclusive growth and development
 - Trade Facilitation and Trade in TF-related services
 - Multilateral Trade Negotiations and Regional Integration

- Research Programme [structure]
 - More Thematic Regional Studies
 - More directed approach (Appointed Lead Advisors to the Secretariat will be responsible for developing scope & methodology and assembling teams)
 - Better funding & more time for implementation (> 12 month)
 - Short-term (Individual) Studies
 - Competitive call for proposals
 - Linked with LDC fellowships
 - Emphasis on capacity building
 - Note: Research programme will evolve based on annual research priority surveys, ARTNeT resources and geographic coverage

Dissemination

- All consultative meetings will be thematic (no annual general review meetings)
 - Meetings will be scheduled based on progress of the research
- More emphasis on policy briefs
- More systematic national level dissemination of research results in LDCs
 - Systematic consultation with Gov. focal point when conducting national-level case studies
- Searchable database of T&I policy studies within LDCs (in cooperation with one RI country focal point)
- On-demand literature review facility

- T&I Policy Research Capacity Building
 - Workshops on trade research methods
 - Annual sequence of two workshops
 - 1st workshop as in Phase I
 - 2nd mini-workshop for participants in 1st workshop who have prepared draft papers applying the tools/methods learned
 - More established researchers and institutions to be resource persons/organizations
 - Hosted by members
 - Learning by doing
 - Through short-term studies and fellowships
 - Through promoting the inclusion of junior researchers in national research teams
 - Workshops for Gov. officials managing/sub-contracting research studies/projects (Subject to additional funds being available)
 - ARTNeT Cells (Feasibility study)
